Lower Umpqua Hospital District has a long history in this community, dating back to the hospital opening on February 3, 1964. It has been our privilege to serve community residents for nearly 60 years. Throughout this time, we have received tremendous community support.

As we look to our upcoming fiscal year (July 1, 2023 to June 30, 2024), we would like to give back to the community who has supported us all of these years. We currently have 177 full-time and 17 part-time employees to rally to this effort. Over the next year, we are asking full-time employees to perform a shift (of 8-10 hours) of paid community service; part-time employees will be asked to perform a shift of 4 hours over the next year.

If everyone participates, this will amount to just under 1,500 hours of service to worthwhile projects in our community. Participation is voluntary; however, we believe our employees will eagerly join this effort, and we want to do what we can to facilitate and support this effort.
